BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amending Section 111.390 (Driver Education Safety Trust Fund), Part 3 (Public Safety and Courts), Chapter 111 (Special Revenue and Trust Accounts), Ordinance Code. Section 111.390 (Driver Education Safety Trust Fund), Part 3 (Public Safety and Courts), Chapter 111 (Special Revenue and Trust Accounts), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 111. SPECIAL REVENUE AND TRUST ACCOUNTS

PART 3. PUBLIC SAFETY AND COURTS

* * *

Sec. 111.390. - Driver Education Safety Trust Fund.

(a) There is hereby created a trust fund to be known as the Driver Education Safety Trust Fund (Fund) established pursuant to the Dori Slosberg Driver Education Safety Act (F.S. § 318.1215). The Clerk of the Circuit Court, in and for Duval County, shall levy an additional §5 §3 with each

civil traffic penalty issued in Duval County and deposit all monies collected into the Fund.

* * *

Section 2. Codification Instructions. The Codifier and the Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and division "table of contents" consistent with the changes set forth herein, including renumbering of sections. Such editorial changes and any other changes necessary to make the Ordinance Code consistent with the intent of this legislation are approved and directed herein, and the changes to the Ordinance Code shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
