ORDINANCE 2025-600

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 111.390 (DRIVER EDUCATION SAFETY TRUST FUND), PART 3 (PUBLIC SAFETY AND COURTS), CHAPTER 111 (SPECIAL REVENUE AND TRUST ACCOUNTS), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO INCREASE THE CIVIL TRAFFIC PENALTY FROM \$3 TO \$5 CONSISTENT WITH THE DORI SLOSBERG DRIVER EDUCATION SAFETY ACT, SECTION 318.1215, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amending Section 111.390 (Driver Education Safety Trust Fund), Part 3 (Public Safety and Courts), Chapter 111 (Special Revenue and Trust Accounts), Ordinance Code. Section 111.390 (Driver Education Safety Trust Fund), Part 3 (Public Safety and Courts), Chapter 111 (Special Revenue and Trust Accounts), *Ordinance Code*, is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 111. SPECIAL REVENUE AND TRUST ACCOUNTS

PART 3. PUBLIC SAFETY AND COURTS

Sec. 111.390. - Driver Education Safety Trust Fund.

(a) There is hereby created a trust fund to be known as the Driver Education Safety Trust Fund (Fund) established pursuant to the Dori Slosberg Driver Education Safety Act (F.S. § 318.1215). The Clerk of the Circuit Court, in and for Duval County, shall levy an additional \$5 ~~\$3~~ with each

1 civil traffic penalty issued in Duval County and deposit
2 all monies collected into the Fund.

4 **Section 2. Codification Instructions.** The Codifier and the
5 Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and
6 division "table of contents" consistent with the changes set forth
7 herein, including renumbering of sections. Such editorial changes and
8 any other changes necessary to make the *Ordinance Code* consistent
9 with the intent of this legislation are approved and directed herein,
10 and the changes to the *Ordinance Code* shall be made forthwith and
11 when inconsistencies are discovered.

12 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
13 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
14 without the Mayor's signature.
