Special Elections Called - At-Large Group 3 Section 1. Council Seat; Qualifying Period, First Special Unitary Election and Special Unitary General Election Provided for. The Council hereby

declares the vacancy in the At-Large Group 3 seat of the City Council as the result of the death of the Honorable Council Member Hazouri on September 11, 2021. In accordance with the provisions of Section 5.06, Charter of the City of Jacksonville, a First Special Unitary Election will be held on Tuesday, December 7, 2021, for the purpose of electing the At-Large Group 3 Council Member for such vacated Office, to serve the unexpired term of the previous At-Large Group 3 Council Member. If no candidate receives a majority of the votes of the Special First Unitary Election, then, in that event, the two candidates with the highest vote totals in the First Special Unitary Election shall participate in a Special Unitary General Election to be held on Tuesday, February 22, 2022. In the event more than one candidate receives the second highest vote total, then each such candidates' name, as well as the name of the candidate with the highest vote total, shall be on the ballot for the Special Unitary General Election. The qualifying period for candidates to be voted upon in the First Special Unitary Election hereby called shall begin at 12:00 p.m. on Monday, September 27, 2021, and close at 12:00 p.m. on Friday, October 1, 2021.
