Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's reappointment of Kim Bryan to the Subdivision Standards and Policy Advisory Committee, as a representative of the Underground Utility Contractor Profession, for a second full-term to expire November 30, 2026.

Background Information: Section 654.142, *Ordinance Code* establishes the Subdivision Standards and Policy Advisory Committee to review and revise standards and policy to implement the objectives of this Chapter and advise the appropriate Council committee of its decisions, with respect to any issues concerning land development except traffic engineering and roadway design issues, including sidewalks, bicycle lanes, multi-use paths or disability access on such facilities.

Section 654.142(a), *Ordinance Code*, provides that five of the members of the Subdivision Standards and Policy Advisory Committee shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the Council, in various categories to include a representative of the Underground Utility Contractor Profession.

Ms. Bryan holds a bachelor's degree from Jacksonville University. She is the Vice President of the Hutson Companies and worked previously for Petticoat-Schmitt Civil Contractors, Inc. Ms. Bryan has a Florida Underground Utility and Excavation certification from the State of Florida, FDEP Stormwater Inspector certification and a Georgia Utility Manager license. She resides in Duval County in council district 6.
