PROGRAM (\$100,000 TO WORKFORCE INDUSTRIAL TRAINING, LLC ("WIT") AND \$100,000 TO FLORIDA STATE COLLEGE AΤ JACKSONVILLE ("FSCJ")); APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND WORKFORCE INDUSTRIAL TRAINING, LLC; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW DIRECT CONTRACT WITH WORKFORCE INDUSTRIAL TRAINING, LLC TO PROVIDE THE SERVICES FOR OPERATION BOOST!; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND FLORIDA STATE COLLEGE AΤ JACKSONVILLE; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION TNSECTION 126.107(G), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW DIRECT CONTRACT WITH FLORIDA STATE COLLEGE AT JACKSONVILLE TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR OPERATION

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BOOST!; WAIVING SECTION 110.112 (ADVANCE OF CITY FUNDS; PROHIBITION AGAINST), PART 1 (THE CITY TREASURY), CHAPTER 110 (CITY TREASURY), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A PARTIAL ADVANCE PAYMENT BY THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

- (c) Explanation of Appropriation The funding above is being appropriated from the Social Justice and Community Investment Special Committee Contingency and to be utilized by WIT and FSCJ for the Operation Boost! program.
- Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for the Operation Boost! program, as more fully described in Exhibit 2 attached hereto. The Operation Boost! program will provide recruitment, training and employment assistance to low-income students and students who face barriers to employment. \$100,000 in funding will be used by WIT to provide cost free training to 50 students who face barriers to employment and

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recidivism. \$100,000 in funding will be used by FSCJ to create one hundred \$750 scholarships for low-income students (\$75,000) and to create a Student Emergency Assistance Fund for low-income students (\$25,000).

Agreement approved and execution authorized. Section 3. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, the Funding Agreement between the City of Jacksonville Workforce Industrial Training, LLC, in substantially the form as attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 3, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 3, Rev WIT Agmt, February 2, 2021 - Finance", and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement"). The Agreement may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the Mayor, or his designee; provided however, no modification to the Agreement may increase the financial obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the Agreement or decrease the duties obligations of the Workforce Industrial Training, LLC as stated in the Agreement, and any such modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City and any other non-substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the Agreement.

Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), Section 4. Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of the professional services of Workforce Industrial Training, LLC, to

provide services for the Operation Boost! program. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

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Section 5. Agreement approved and execution authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, the Funding Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Florida State College at Jacksonville, in substantially the form as attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 4, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 4, Rev FSCJ Agmt, February 2, 2021 - Finance", and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement") to provide services for the Operation Boost! program. The Agreement may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the Mayor, or his designee; provided however, no modification to the Agreement may increase the financial obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the Agreement or decrease the duties and obligations of Florida State College of Jacksonville as stated in the Agreement, and any such modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City and any other non-substantive changes that do

substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the Agreement.

Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), Section 6. Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of the professional services of Florida State College of Jacksonville to provide services for the Operation Boost! program. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Waiving Section 110.112, Ordinance Code. Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition against), Part 1 (The City Treasury), Chapter 110 (City Treasury), Ordinance Code, is hereby waived to allow for a partial advance payment as described in the Agreements.

Section 7. Oversight. The Mayor is requested to appoint the Office of Grants and Contract Compliance to oversee the project in Section 2 above and to ensure compliance with all other appropriate laws.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.

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
