5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$2,137,516.77  
6 (\$1,637,516.77 FROM THE FIRE STATION NO. 75 LAND  
7 ACCOUNT AND \$500,000.00 FROM THE FIRE STATION  
8 NO. 75 ENGINEERING AND DESIGN ACCOUNT) TO THE  
9 FIRE STATION NO. 75 OTHER CONSTRUCTION COSTS  
10 ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO COMPLETE  
11 CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW FIRE STATION NO. 75, AS  
12 INITIATED BY B.T. 22-097; AMENDING THE 2022-2026  
13 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY  
14 ORDINANCE 2021-505-E TO TRANSFER FUNDS FOR  
15 COMPLETION OF CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW FIRE  
16 STATION NO. 75; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,  
20 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
22 listed in subsection (b):

29 (c) Explanation of appropriation:

30 The funding above is a reallocation of funds from the Fire  
31 Station No. 75 Land and Engineering and Design Accounts to

1 the Fire Station No. 75 Other Construction Costs Account  
2 to pay for completion of construction of the new Fire  
3 Station No. 75.

4 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
5 Section 1 is reallocate funds to complete the construction of Fire  
6 Station No. 75 which will be located at Firestone Road and Wilson  
7 Boulevard. Land has been acquired for this new station and this  
8 project was identified in the City's 2021-2025 Capital Improvement  
9 Program and the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department's 2020 Capital  
10 Study to reduce response times for fire and EMS runs. These remaining  
11 funds are necessary to complete construction of the new station.

12 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance  
13 2021-505-E, adopting the 2022-2026 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan  
14 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is  
15 hereby amended to transfer \$2,137,516.77 (\$500,000.00 from the Fire  
16 Station No. 75 Design and Engineering expenditures/project phase and  
17 \$1,637,516.77 from the Land Acquisition and Site Preparation  
18 expenditures/project phase) to the Fire Station No. 75 Construction  
19 expenditures/project phase as more fully described in the Project  
20 Information Sheet attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein  
21 by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this  
22 amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will  
23 be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such  
24 deferral will delay the City's ability to complete construction of  
25 the new Fire Station No. 75 to provide reduced response times and  
26 necessary emergency services in this area of the community.

27 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of  
28 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
29 Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment  
30 set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an  
31 amendment to Ordinance 2021-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-

1 Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2021-505-E shall  
2 continue in full force and effect.

3 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
4 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
5 without the Mayor's signature.
