6 A RESOLUTION REAPPOINTING MARSHA JACKSON AS A  
7 MEMBER OF THE JACKSONVILLE - DUVAL COUNTY  
8 COUNCIL ON ELDER AFFAIRS, AS THE COUNCIL  
9 DISTRICT 10 REPRESENTATIVE, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER  
10 82, *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR A SECOND FULL TERM  
11 EXPIRING JUNE 30, 2025; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE  
12 DATE.

14 **WHEREAS**, Marsha Jackson was appointed to the Jacksonville -  
15 Duval County Council on Elder Affairs through 2022-269-A as a District  
16 8 representative; and

17 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to 2022-800-E, 2023-281-E, and the  
18 Settlement Agreement in case number 3:22-cv-493-MMH-LLL, the *Charter*  
19 *of the City of Jacksonville* was amended to approve and enact the City  
20 of Jacksonville Redistricting Plan establishing City Council  
21 Districts with new boundaries; and

22 **WHEREAS**, with the new Council District boundaries, Marsha  
23 Jackson now resides in Council District 10; now therefore

24 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

25 **Section 1. Reappointment.** The Council hereby reappoints  
26 Marsha Jackson, a Duval County resident, to the Jacksonville - Duval  
27 County Council on Elder Affairs, as the representative for Council  
28 District 10, pursuant to Chapter 82, *Ordinance Code*, for a second  
29 full term expiring June 30, 2025.

30 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become  
31 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective

1 without the Mayor's signature.
