**ORDINANCE 2025-222-E**

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING ORDINANCE 2024-634-E TO ADDRESS REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 121.104 (REVIEW OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION), PART 1 (POLICE AND FIRE PENSION FUND ADMINISTRATION), CHAPTER 121 (POLICE AND FIREFIGHTERS PENSION PLAN), *ORDINANCE CODE*; PROVIDING DIRECTION TO THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION; PROVIDING FOR RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, on September 10, 2024, the City Council approved Ordinance 2024-634-E, which included a change to Section 121.105 (Pensioner's rights upon reemployment by City), *Ordinance Code*; and

**WHEREAS**, per Section 121.104 (Review of proposed legislation), *Ordinance Code*, Ordinance 2024-634-E was supposed to have been presented to the Board of Trustees, Police and Fire Pension Fund for review and comment; and

**WHEREAS**, additionally, an actuarial report together with recommendations and comments from the State Division of Retirement was to have accompanied Ordinance 2024-634-E; and

**WHEREAS**, an actuarial analysis, attached as **Exhibit 1**, has since been performed and it was determined that Ordinance 2024-634-E "will not have an actuarial impact on the Fund for advance funding purposes"; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2024-634-E and the analysis have been provided to the State Division of Retirement; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of the consideration of this ordinance, the

1 Council has sought the review and comment of the Board of Trustees,  
2 Police and Fire Pension Fund on the changes enacted per Ordinance  
3 2024-634-E; and

4 **WHEREAS,** it is the will of the Council to comply with the  
5 requirements of Section 121.104, *Ordinance Code*; now therefore

6 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

7 **Section 1. Directing Legislative Services to Place This**  
8 **Ordinance in the File for Ordinance 2024-634-E.** The Legislative  
9 Services Division is directed to place this ordinance in the file for  
10 Ordinance 2024-634-E.

11 **Section 2. Retroactive Applicability and Findings.** This  
12 Ordinance shall be retroactive in application so that the requirements  
13 set forth in Section 121.104, *Ordinance Code*, are satisfied in the  
14 enactment of Ordinance 2024-634-E.

15 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
16 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
17 without the Mayor's signature.
