Bill Summary: This bill appropriates a \$100,000 grant from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement ("FDLE") through its fiscal year 2023-2024 State Financial Assistance for Fentanyl Eradication ("S.A.F.E.") Program to the PSBU Grants/Fentanyl and Opioid Eradication ("FOE") Project to combat illegal fentanyl activity. It designates the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office as the oversight department for the project.

Background Information: The Florida Legislature established state funding in 2023 to conduct investigations designed to combat illegal fentanyl activity under the S.A.F.E. Program. This grant funding will cover overtime-related expenses to increase JSO's resources in conducting fentanyl-related investigations.

Policy Impact Area: Public health/safety

Fiscal Impact: This bill appropriates a \$100,000 grant from FDLE to pay for overtime-related expenses for JSO officers conducting fentanyl-related investigations.
