AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$250,000.00 FROM THE CECIL COMMERCE CENTER TRUST FUND TO THE 2023 AUTHORIZED CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDING TO COMPLETE THE CECIL PIPING REPAIR PROJECT DUE TO INCREASED CONSTRUCTION COSTS, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-116; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; AMENDING THE 2023-2027 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2022-505-E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2022-2023 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum from the account listed in subsection (a) to the account listed in subsection (b):

account to the 2023 Authorized Capital Projects Fund, Cecil Piping Repair - Other Construction Costs account to provide additional funding due to increased construction costs attendant to the Cecil Piping Repair Project (the "Project").

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to appropriate additional funds to the Cecil Piping Repair Project. This appropriation is necessary to complete the Project as a result of increased construction costs for the Project.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect this appropriation of funds to the Project, as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
