BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

25 Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, 26 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated 27 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) 28 listed in subsection (b):

Neighborhoods USA is a national, non-profit organization 23 created in 1975 for the purpose of building and strengthening 24 neighborhood organizations. The NUSA Conference is hosted annually 25 to facilitate the development of partnerships among neighborhood 26 organizations, government and the private sector with a goal of 27 strengthening every neighborhood. The funds appropriated herein will Jacksonville 2.8 allow neighborhood organizations throughout to 29 participate in the NUSA Conference for access to meaningful workshops, 30 national networking opportunities and sharing of best practices.

Section 3. Reverter. Any funds that are not utilized for

1 the purpose of covering the costs of recognized Jacksonville 2 neighborhood organizations' attendance at the 2025 NUSA Conference 3 shall be returned to the General Fund Special Council Contingency 4 account.

5 Section 4. Oversight Department. The Neighborhoods
6 Department shall oversee the project described herein.

7 Section 5. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant 8 to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this 9 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the 10 2025 NUSA Conference is scheduled to begin on May 20, 2025, and the Council would like to make these funds available as soon as 11 costs of recognized 12 practicable to cover the Jacksonville 13 neighborhood organizations' attendance at the 2025 NUSA Conference.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
