Type of Action: Resolution supporting House Bill 987; directing the Chief of the Legislative Services Division to transmit a copy of the resolution.

Bill Summary: This resolution expresses the Council's support for House Bill 987. HB 987 would designate a portion of State Road 10/West Beaver Street between King Street and Acorn Street in Duval County as "Harry Frisch Street." The resolution also directs the Chief of the Legislative Services Division to send a copy of the resolution to the District 2 Secretary of the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the members of the Duval County Legislative Delegation.

Background Information: During the 2025 Legislative Session, the Florida Legislature passed HB 987, which makes honorary designations of transportation facilities throughout Florida and directs FDOT to erect suitable markers for those designations. It also designates a portion of State Road 10/West Beaver Street as "Harry Frisch Street." Additionally, under Section 334.701, *Florida Statutes*, a city or county commission must pass a resolution in support of a particular honorary designation before road markers are erected. This resolution expresses the City's desire to honor Harry Frisch and requests that the FDOT erect markers designating the portion of State Road 10/West Beaver Street as "Harry Frisch Street."

Policy Impact Area: Honorary designations, transportation

Fiscal Impact: No direct cost to the City.
