The funding above represents an appropriation of \$152,362 from a General Fund Operating Special Council Contingency account to the Restore Endangered Historic Adaptable Buildings ("REHAB") Special Revenue Fund - Miscellaneous Grants and Aids account, to provide additional funds for the REHAB Program, originally established by Ordinance 2023-316-E, to support the repair, rehabilitation and restoration of non-residential, income-producing historic buildings, mixed-use historic buildings, and historic buildings owned by not-for-profit corporations.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide additional funds to support the REHAB Program. The REHAB Program is administered by the Historic Preservation Section of the Planning and Development Department in accordance with the REHAB Special Revenue Guidelines approved by Ordinance 2023-316-E, as subsequently modified by Ordinance 2024-847-E. This appropriation will provide additional funds for grants issued in accordance with said Guidelines for repair, rehabilitation and restoration of certain historic buildings types of in Duval County including non-residential, income-producing historic buildings, mixed-use historic buildings, and historic buildings owned by not-for-profit corporations.

Section 3. Oversight. The Historic Preservation Section of the Planning and Development Department shall continue to have oversight of the program described herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
