**ORDINANCE 2025-430**

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 CITY GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE BOSELLI FOUNDATION, INC. ("BOSELLI") FOR THE TEACHER FELLOWSHIP AND MENTORING PROGRAMS AS ORIGINALLY AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE 2024-839-E, SUBJECT TO A REVISED TERM SHEET AND BUDGET AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Ordinance 2024-839-E, the City Council appropriated \$500,000 to The Boselli Foundation, Inc. ("Boselli") to support the Teach Fellowship and Mentoring Programs (the "Program(s)") in fiscal year 2024-2025; and

**WHEREAS,** Boselli has requested certain adjustments to the approved Term Sheet and Budget for the Programs to reallocate City funds to line-items that better support the needs of each Program; and

**WHEREAS,** because these adjustments amount to more than 10% of the affected line-items, City Council approval of the changes is required; now therefore

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

**Section 1. Approval and Authorization to Execute.** There is

1 hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation  
2 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of  
3 the City an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 City Grant  
4 Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and The Boselli Foundation,  
5 Inc. for the Programs, originally authorized by Ordinance 2024-839-E,  
6 to extend the grant term to expire on April 30, 2026, subject to the  
7 revised Term Sheet and Budget attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and  
8 incorporated herein by this reference, and all other contracts and  
9 documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the  
10 agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate  
11 the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and  
12 approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the  
13 City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and  
14 indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601,  
15 *Ordinance Code*.

16 The Teacher Fellowship Program is a year-long program that  
17 provides qualified teachers in kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade  
18 classrooms with professional learning and skills development  
19 opportunities. The Mentoring Program fosters leadership development  
20 for young men by promoting self-worth, communication skills and the  
21 ability to lead oneself and others through increased self-awareness.  
22 The City funds were originally appropriated to support various  
23 administrative costs for Boselli to operate the Programs. The revised  
24 Term Sheet and Budget reflect a reallocation of funds from certain  
25 salaries and benefits for positions within the Programs as well as  
26 funds allocated for certain occupancy expenses and direct client  
27 expenses and redirects those funds to pay the costs for dental and  
28 other benefits for positions supporting the Programs and other  
29 occupancy expenses, including insurance, postage, professional fees  
30 and services, and supplies. A spreadsheet outlining the various  
31 changes to the respective Program budgets is attached hereto as

**Exhibit 2.**

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
