 - The funding above represents an appropriation of 1) \$98,000.00 from the Insured Programs Fund Premium Paid

Property Account to the Self Insurance Fund - Other Professional Services Account to provide funding for onsite physical therapy and industrial performance program services provided to the Jacksonville Fire & Rescue Department, and 2) \$121,020.81 from the Premium Paid -Property account and \$163,488.00 from the Premium Paid -GL, Auto, Policy & Misc account to the Premium Paid -Special Events (\$128,652.81), Premium Paid - Voting Precincts (\$46,548.00), Premium Paid - Out of State Auto Liability (\$9,357.00), and Premium Paid -Medical Malpractice (\$1,951.00) accounts within the Insured Programs Fund to increase the budgeted amounts based upon actual expenditures.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund onsite physical therapy and industrial performance program services through fiscal year 2023-2024 in the aggregate amount of \$98,000.00 to Unify Health Services, LLC, pursuant to that certain Contract for Physical Therapist for Jacksonville Fire & Rescue Department, Contract # 71619-22, dated April 27, 2022 (the "Contract"). Previously, the Contract had been funded by grant and matching funds. Additionally, \$186,508.81 is being appropriated between accounts within the Insured Programs Fund to increase the budgeted amounts based upon actual expenditures.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
