**Bill Summary:** The bill appropriates the sum of \$1,905,803.00 in Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds, authorized by the CARES Act, to be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the COVID-19 pandemic among individuals and families who are homeless or receiving homeless assistance; and to support additional homeless assistance and homelessness prevention activities to mitigate the impacts of COVID-19. **Background Information:** The funds may be used to cover or reimburse allowable costs incurred by a locality before the award of funding (including prior to the signing of the CARES Act) to prevent, prepare for and respond to COVID-19. Up to 10% of funds may be used for administrative costs.

**Policy Impact Area:** Public health and safety

**Fiscal Impact:** No additional financial impacts anticipated. Up to 10% of funds may be used for administrative costs.
