7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A \$179,370.75 GRANT  
8 FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY,  
9 FUNDED THROUGH THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT  
10 PROGRAM AND APPROVED BY THE FLORIDA DIVISION  
11 OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, FOR THE PURCHASE AND  
12 INSTALLATION OF A PERMANENT GENERATOR AT THE  
13 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH BUILDING, AS INITIATED BY  
14 B.T. 20-093; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE  
15 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION  
16 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON  
17 BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE HAZARD MITIGATION  
18 GRANT PROGRAM CONTRACT NUMBER H0337 BETWEEN  
19 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE FLORIDA  
20 DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT; PROVIDING  
21 FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC BUILDINGS DIVISION  
22 OF THE CITY'S DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS;  
23 AMENDING THE 2020-2024 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL  
24 IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE  
25 2019-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT  
26 ENTITLED "DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH GENERATOR  
27 REPLACEMENT"; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

29 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

30 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,

1 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
2 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
3 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

10 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

11 The funding above is a grant from the Federal Emergency  
12 Management Agency, funded through the Hazard Mitigation  
13 Grant Program and approved by the Florida Division of  
14 Emergency Management for the purchase and installation of  
15 a permanent generator at the Department of Health  
16 Building.

17 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
18 Section 1 is to provide funding for the purchase and installation  
19 of a permanent generator at the Department of Health Building. The  
20 purchase and installation of a permanent generator will reduce  
21 and/or mitigate the damage that might occur as the result of severe  
22 weather or other hazards.

23 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby  
24 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation  
25 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on  
26 behalf of the City, the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Contract  
27 Number H0337 between the City of Jacksonville and the Florida  
28 Division of Emergency Management, a copy of which has been placed  
29 **ON FILE** with the Office of Legislative Services.

30 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Public Buildings Division  
31 of the Department of Public Works shall oversee the project

1 described herein.

2           **Section 5.           CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being  
3 the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City  
4 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to  
5 provide funding for the project entitled "Department of Health  
6 Generator Replacement." The project is more fully described in the  
7 Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 2**,  
8 labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised CIP, August 17, 2020 -  
9 NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council  
10 finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next  
11 annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best  
12 interests of the community because such deferral will result in the  
13 City's loss of needed grant dollars. Pursuant to Section  
14 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of this ordinance requires  
15 the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present  
16 at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this  
17 section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance  
18 2019-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital  
19 Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue  
20 in full force and effect.

21           **Section 6.           Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
23 without the Mayor's signature.
