Bill Summary: This bill confirms the appointment of Cory Driscoll to the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee, as a community representative, replacing Tim Snyder for a first term ending December 31, 2025.

Background Information: The Cultural Service Grant Program Committee is established pursuant to Chapter 118, Part 6, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to recommend to the Cultural Council Board of Directors the organizations to be funded and the amount of the funding. Section 118.605, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the membership of the committee shall include seven individuals selected from community wide and confirmed by the City Council.

Mr. Driscoll serves as a Certified Financial Planner and Vice President/Co-Owner of The Driscoll Group, Inc., an independent Financial Planning and Wealth Management firm located in the Southside area of Jacksonville. Mr. Driscoll resides in Council District 14.
