ORDINANCE 2024-763

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$692,834 FROM THE SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND (THE "FUND") TO FUND VARIOUS CRIME PREVENTION AND ENFORCEMENT EXPENDITURES AND ACTIVITIES INCLUDING: (1) TRANSFERRING \$12,500 FROM THE FUND TO THE TEEN DRIVER SPECIAL REVENUE FUND IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 111.365, ORDINANCE CODE, TO FUND THE TEEN DRIVER CHALLENGE PROGRAM; (2) TRANSFERRING \$12,500 FROM THE FUND TO THE POLICE EXPLORER TRUST FUND IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 111.340, ORDINANCE CODE, TO FUND THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE ("JSO") POLICE EXPLORER POST; (3) \$248,610 FOR SECURITY CAMERA MAINTENANCE FOR JSO FACILITIES; (4) \$90,000 FOR SPECIALIZED JSO COMPUTER WORKSTATIONS; (5) \$46,399 FOR UTVS FOR VARIOUS JSO UNITS; (6) \$32,825 FOR JSO SATELLITE PHONES AND ACCESSORIES; (7) AND \$250,000 FOR JSO FIREARMS LAB EQUIPMENT, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 25-006; AMENDING THE 2025-2029 FIVE-YEAR IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2024-505-E TO REFLECT THE REALLOCATION OF FUNDS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$692,834.00 from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund (the "Fund") to procure contractual services and equipment and includes transfers of Fund dollars to other City funds for various crime prevention and law enforcement expenditures and activities in accordance with the Ordinance Code and Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, as more specifically outlined herein.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to transfer \$12,500 from the Fund to the Teen Driver Special Revenue Fund for the Teen Driver Challenge Program in accordance with Section 111.365, Ordinance Code, and to transfer \$12,500 from the Fund to the Police Explorers Trust Fund for the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office ("JSO") Police Explorer Post in accordance with Section 111.340, Ordinance Code. In addition, this appropriation includes \$248,610 to procure security camera maintenance for JSO facilities, \$90,000 to procure specialized JSO computer workstations, \$46,399 to procure UTVs for various JSO units, \$32,825 to procure satellite phones and accessories for JSO, and \$250,000 to procure JSO firearms lab equipment.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2024-505-E, adopting the 2025-2029 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan

(the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended by removing the project entitled "Haines St. Property Facility - Firearms Laboratory Renovation" due to cancellation of the project. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment 5 of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such 6 7 deferral will unnecessarily delay the procurement of specialized equipment for the firearms lab leading to additional backlog in items 9 waiting for ballistic testing.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2024-505-E. In all other respects, the CIP approved by Ordinance 2024-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
