A RESOLUTION APPOINTING COUNCIL PRESIDENT NICK HOWLAND AS CHAIR OF THE DUVAL COUNTY TOURIST DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL, PURSUANT TO SECTION 70.102(A)(1), *ORDINANCE CODE*, REPLACING COUNCIL MEMBER KEVIN CARRICO, FOR A TERM ENDING JUNE 30, 2027; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appointment. The Council hereby appoints Council President Nick Howland, as Chair of the Duval County Tourist Development Council, in accordance with Section 70.102(a)(1), *Ordinance Code*, replacing Council Member Kevin Carrico, for a term ending June 30, 2027.

Section 2. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is the need to enable the appointee to be seated timely to participate in the Duval County Tourist Development Council's next meeting.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
