7 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF
8 WILLIAM T. MAULE, A DUVAL COUNTY RESIDENT AND
9 AN ATTORNEY, AS A MEMBER OF THE JACKSONVILLE
10 ETHICS COMMISSION, PURSUANT TO SECTION
11 602.912, *ORDINANCE CODE*, REAPPOINTED BY THE
12 PUBLIC DEFENDER FOR THE FOURTH JUDICIAL
13 CIRCUIT FOR A SECOND FULL TERM ENDING DECEMBER
14 31, 2028; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 **WHEREAS**, the Public Defender for the Fourth Judicial Circuit
17 nominated William Maule to replace Mary Bland Love as the Public
18 Defender's appointee for a first term ending December 31, 2025, as
19 confirmed by Council in Resolution 2022-806-A; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the Public Defender desires to nominate William T.
21 Maule for a second full term ending December 31, 2028; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Maule meets the qualifications of Section
23 602.912(d), *Ordinance Code*, as he is a Duval County resident and an
24 attorney; now therefore

25 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

26 **Section 1. Reappointment Confirmation.** The Council
27 hereby confirms the Public Defender for the Fourth Judicial
28 Circuit's reappointment of William T. Maule, a Duval County
29 resident and an attorney, meeting the requirements of Section
30 602.912(d), *Ordinance Code*, to the Jacksonville Ethics Commission,
31 for a second term expiring December 31, 2028. Correspondence from

1 the Fourth Judicial Circuit Public Defender, Charlie Cofer,
2 reappointing Mr. Maule is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**.

3 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
4 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
5 without the Mayor's signature.
