**ORDINANCE 2025-101-E**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$152,362 FROM A GENERAL FUND OPERATING SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE RESTORE ENDANGERED HISTORIC ADAPTABLE BUILDINGS ("REHAB") SPECIAL REVENUE FUND - MISCELLANEOUS GRANTS AND AIDS ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR THE REHAB PROGRAM, ORIGINALLY ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE 2023-316-E, TO SUPPORT THE REPAIR, REHABILITATION AND RESTORATION OF CERTAIN TYPES OF HISTORIC BUILDINGS IN DUVAL COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR CONTINUED OVERSIGHT BY THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION SECTION OF THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

**Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

1           The funding above represents an appropriation of \$152,362  
2           from a General Fund Operating Special Council Contingency  
3           account to the Restore Endangered Historic Adaptable  
4           Buildings ("REHAB") Special Revenue Fund - Miscellaneous  
5           Grants and Aids account, to provide additional funds for  
6           the REHAB Program, originally established by Ordinance  
7           2023-316-E, to support the repair, rehabilitation and  
8           restoration of non-residential, income-producing historic  
9           buildings, mixed-use historic buildings, and historic  
10          buildings owned by not-for-profit corporations.

11          **Section 2.        Purpose.**   The purpose of the appropriation in  
12          Section 1 is to provide additional funds to support the REHAB Program.  
13          The REHAB Program is administered by the Historic Preservation Section  
14          of the Planning and Development Department in accordance with the  
15          REHAB Special Revenue Guidelines approved by Ordinance 2023-316-E,  
16          as subsequently modified by Ordinance 2024-847-E. This appropriation  
17          will provide additional funds for grants issued in accordance with  
18          said Guidelines for repair, rehabilitation and restoration of certain  
19          types of historic buildings in Duval County including  
20          non-residential, income-producing historic buildings, mixed-use  
21          historic buildings, and historic buildings owned by not-for-profit  
22          corporations.

23          **Section 3.        Oversight.**   The Historic Preservation Section of  
24          the Planning and Development Department shall continue to have  
25          oversight of the program described herein.

26          **Section 4.        Effective Date.**   This Ordinance shall become  
27          effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
28          without the Mayor's signature.
