5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$283,392.00 FROM THE
6 U. S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES
7 RYAN WHITE HIV/AIDS PROGRAM PART A COVID-19 TO
8 PROVIDE HIV SERVICES RESPONDING TO CORONAVIRUS
9 DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) AND RELATED HEALTH AND
10 SUPPORT SERVICES TO PERSONS LIVING WITH
11 HIV/AIDS AND RESIDING IN THE JACKSONVILLE
12 TRANSITIONAL GRANT AREA (TGA), AS INITIATED BY
13 B.T. 20-074; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY
14 THE SOCIAL SERVICES DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT
15 OF PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES;
16 REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE;
17 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Appropriation Authorized.** For the Grant Year
21 2020/2021, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated
22 the indicated sum from the account listed in subsection (a) to the
23 account listed in subsection (b):

30 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

31 The funding above is a grant from the U. S. Department of

1 Health and Human Services, Health Resources & Services
2 Administration (HRSA) for Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program
3 Part A COVID-19 in order to provide HIV services
4 responding to Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) and
5 related health and support services to persons living
6 with HIV/AIDS and residing in the Transitional Grant Area
7 composed of Duval, Nassau, Clay, and St. Johns Counties.
8 No City match is required.

9 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
10 Section 1 is to enhance services during the coronavirus disease
11 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic by providing onetime funding to support
12 preventing, preparing for, and responding to COVID-19 as needs
13 evolve for Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program recipients, as outlined in
14 the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act. Pursuant to
15 Office of Management and Budget Memorandum M2017, Administrative
16 Relief for Recipients and Applicants of Federal Financial
17 Assistance Directly Impacted by the Novel Coronavirus (COVIC-19),
18 HRSA authorizes a recipient to incur pre-award costs prior to the
19 effective date of a federal award dating back to January 20, 2020.
20 The Grant Budget Year is April 1, 2020, through March 31, 2021. A
21 copy of the Notice of Award from HRSA is attached hereto as **Exhibit**
22 **2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

23 **Section 3. Oversight Department.** The Social Services
24 Division of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Community
25 Services shall oversee the project described herein.

26 **Section 4. Requesting one cycle emergency passage**
27 **pursuant to Council Rules 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency
28 passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the
29 emergency is the need to provide services and meet the needs of
30 clients in the current COVID-19 pandemic.

31 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become

1 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
2 without the Mayor's signature.
