RESOLUTION REGARDING TRANSPARENCY ΙN Α REQUESTING THE MAYOR, GOVERNMENT; OR HER DESIGNEE, PROVIDE A REPORT TO THE CITY COUNCIL FINANCE COMMITTEE ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 7, 2025, PERTAINING TO: (1) FEDERAL GRANTS, (2) HOUSING OF UNAUTHORIZED ALIENS, AND (3) ALL FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 BUDGETED AND ACTUAL EXPENDITURES, IN WHATEVER FORM, ON OR TO NON-PROFIT ENTITIES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has repeatedly stated that transparency in government is of tantamount importance as it not only fosters good government, but highlights and bolsters the trust of the people of Jacksonville in both the operation of this consolidated government and its stewardship of the taxpayer's dollars; and

WHEREAS, recently the City Council considered Ordinance 2025-138 which, in part, sought to further this goal of increased transparency by requiring the Mayor, or her designee, to provide a report to the City Council Finance Committee pertaining to federal grants, policies and practices regarding diversity, equity and inclusion, housing of unauthorized aliens, and Fiscal Year 2024-2025 budgeted and actual expenditures on or to non-profit entities; and

WHEREAS, for reasons not centered on the aforementioned report, Ordinance 2025-138 was vetoed by the Mayor and the veto was sustained by the City Council on June 24, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City Council still finds value in receiving

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information regarding federal grants, housing of unauthorized aliens, and Fiscal Year 2024-2025 expenditures on or to non-profits as it can assist the Council in making a variety of decisions pertaining to City budgeting, implementation or modification of City policies, and furtherance of transparency in government; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Request for Report. The Mayor, or her designee(s), is hereby requested to present a report to the City Council Finance Committee on or before October 7, 2025, as follows:

- a) Federal Grants:
 - (1)Provide a list of all grants between the City of Jacksonville/Duval County and the federal government and any of its offices, divisions, agencies, etc. Included in the report must be a brief description of the grant, the funding entity, and information as to whether the City has received notice of any intent to withhold funds or to cease reimbursement under any grant or if the Mayor or Grant Administrator anticipates such action to occur.
 - Confirmation that the City of Jacksonville is in compliance (2) with all applicable federal and state anti-discrimination laws, rules, regulations and policies. For instances in which the City is not in compliance with a law, rule, regulation or policy, the Mayor must outline a plan and timeline to achieve compliance with such law, rule, regulation or policy.
- b) Housing of Unauthorized Aliens:
 - Information regarding the number of unauthorized aliens, (1)if any, residing in public housing under the jurisdiction and control of the City or any of its independent agencies. The term "unauthorized alien" shall have the same meaning as found in Section 908.111, Florida Statutes.

c) Expenditures on Non-Profits: 1 2 (1)Information regarding any and all budgeted and actual 3 expenditures, in whatever form, on or to non-profit 4 entities in Fiscal Year 2024-2025. 5 Section 2. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become 6 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 7 without the Mayor's signature. 8 9 Form Approved: 10 11 /s/Mary E.
