17 Section 3. Authorization of Part-Time Hours. There are 18 hereby approved part-time hours more fully described in R.C. 25-111, 19 attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by this 20 reference.

21 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office 22 shall oversee administration of the grant and shall provide oversight 23 of the project and part-time hours described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
