ORDINANCE 2025-338

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$175,000.00 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT, THROUGH ITS FY 24-25 STATE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR FENTANYL ERADICATION (S.A.F.E.) IN FLORIDA PROGRAM, TO THE PSBU GRANTS/OPERATION STRIKING DISTANCE FY 25-26 PROJECT TO COMBAT ILLEGAL FENTANYL ACTIVITY, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 25-074; AUTHORIZING PART-TIME HOURS, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 25-111; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of grant funds from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, through its FY 24-25 State Financial Assistance for

1 Fentanyl Eradication (S.A.F.E.) in Florida Program, to the
2 Jacksonville Sheriff's Office PSBU Grants/Operation
3 Striking Distance FY 25-26 Project to combat illegal
4 fentanyl activity. The Grant period commenced on February
5 27, 2025, and continues through June 30, 2025, and may be
6 extended to December 31, 2025. No local match is required.

7 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
8 Section 1 is to utilize the grant funding from the Florida Department
9 of Law Enforcement through its FY 24-25 State Financial Assistance
10 for Fentanyl Eradication (S.A.F.E.) in Florida Program, to conduct
11 investigations designed to combat illegal fentanyl activity and will
12 cover expenses related to overtime and part-time hours related to
13 such investigations. A copy of the Financial Assistance Agreement
14 outlining the terms and conditions relative to the grant and use of
15 the grant funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated
16 herein by this reference.

17 **Section 3. Authorization of Part-Time Hours.** There are
18 hereby approved part-time hours more fully described in R.C. 25-111,
19 attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by this
20 reference.

21 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
22 shall oversee administration of the grant and shall provide oversight
23 of the project and part-time hours described herein.

24 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
25 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
26 without the Mayor's signature.
