

Backup Information for 2023 FIND Grant Application Legislation

The following four (4) projects were recommended for the 2023 FIND grant project list by a subcommittee of the Jacksonville Waterways Commission at their meeting on 11/4/2022.

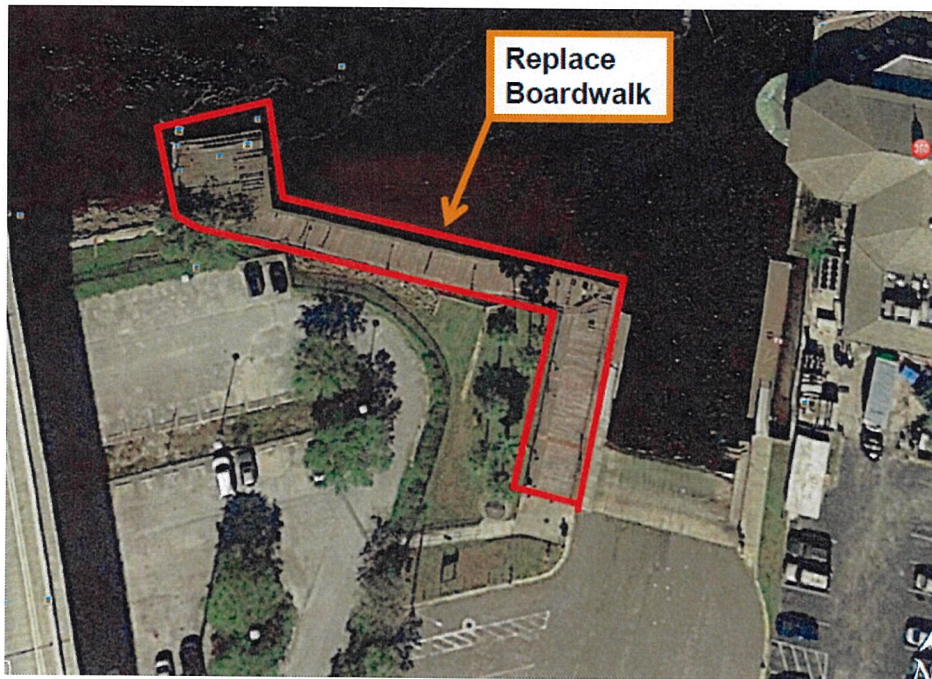
Oak Harbor Boat Ramp Bulkhead

- The design phase grant was awarded during the 2022 grant cycle to replace the failing bulkhead at this boat ramp which provides access to the Intracoastal Waterway just south of Mayport.
- This project is recommended for a 2023 FIND grant application in the amount of \$1,760,000 (\$800,000 FIND award request plus \$960,000 City cost).
- Expect to complete design and permitting by September 2023 to be eligible for a 2023 grant award.
- Expect to receive grant award in October 2023 and move forward with construction in 2024.
- Below image shows an aerial of the site.



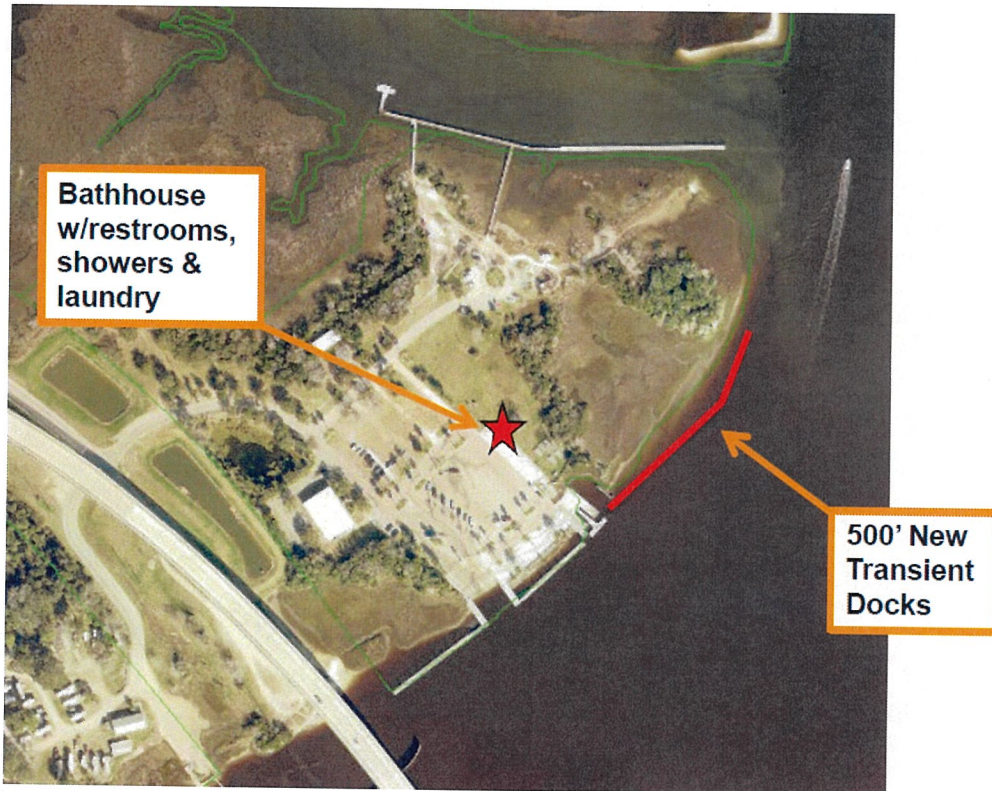
St. Johns Marina Boardwalk

- This boardwalk was destroyed by Hurricane Irma and the replacement structure has been designed and permitted by FEMA will not provide the needed funding to construct.
- This project is recommended for a 2023 FIND grant application in the amount of \$1,320,000 (\$600,000 FIND award request plus \$720,000 City cost).
- Expect to receive grant award in October 2023 and move forward with construction in 2024.

Sisters Creek Dock Extension & Bathhouse

- This is a new design project to develop a 500 LF extension of floating dock at Sisters Creek Marina at Jim King Park to serve transient boaters. Project also includes design and permitting for a bathhouse with restrooms, showers and laundry facilities to further support boaters.
- This project is recommended for a 2023 FIND grant application in the amount of \$770,000 (\$350,000 FIND award request plus \$420,000 City cost).
- Expect to receive grant award in October 2023 and move forward with design in 2024.

Downtown Dredging

- This is a new design project to evaluate and identify the dredging needs at the multiple public docks, ramps and marinas in downtown Jacksonville. Then, a dredge design project and permitting will be developed for the areas identified in need of dredging.
- This project is recommended for a 2022 FIND grant application in the amount of \$550,000 (\$250,000 FIND award request plus \$300,000 City cost).
- Expect to receive grant award in October 2023 and move forward with design in 2024.
