A RESOLUTION STRONGLY ENCOURAGING THE BOARD OF THE JACKSONVILLE HOUSING AUTHORITY (JHA) TO DELAY SELECTION OF THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE JACKSONVILLE HOUSING AUTHORITY FOR THE LATER OF TWO MONTHS OR WHEN THE FULL SEVEN MEMBER BOARD FOR THE JACKSONVILLE HOUSING AUTHORITY HAS BEEN SEATED; STRONGLY ENCOURAGING THE BOARD OF THE JACKSONVILLE HOUSING AUTHORITY TO REVIEW THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL'S REPORT OF INVESTIGATION; DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES TO FORWARD A COPY OF THERESOLUTION UPON ADOPTION ΤО THE HOUSING JACKSONVILLE AUTHORITY BOARD; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Housing Authority Board has been actively searching for a Chief Executive Officer (CEO) for the Jacksonville Housing Authority, and has pared down the applicants for the position to two individuals; and

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Housing Authority Board is comprised of seven appointed members; and

WHEREAS, currently of the seven board member seats, three of the seats are currently vacant; and

WHEREAS, due to the utmost importance of the selection of a

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new CEO to the Jacksonville Housing Authority and the City itself, the input of a full board is instrumental and necessary for the selection of the CEO; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Encouraging the JHA Board to delay selection Section 1. of the Chief Executive Officer. The Council strongly encourages the Jacksonville Housing Authority Board to delay the selection of the Chief Executive Officer of the Jacksonville Housing Authority for the later of two months or when the full seven member board for the Jacksonville Housing Authority has been seated.

Section 2. Encouraging the JHA Board to review the Inspector General's recommendations from the Report of Investigation. The Council strongly encourages the Jacksonville Housing Authority Board to review the recommendations of October 28, 2019 Inspector General's Report of Investigation.

Directing to forward. Section 3. The Chief of Legislative Services Division is hereby directed to forward a copy of this resolution upon adoption to the Jacksonville Housing Authority Board.

Section 4. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of emergency is that the Jacksonville Housing Authority Board has scheduled a meeting for September 21, 2020 to continue with the interview and selection process of a new CEO.

Effective Date. This resolution shall become Section 5. effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
