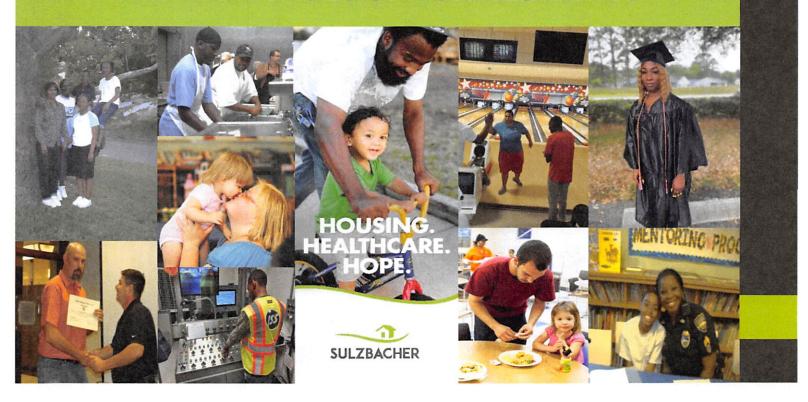

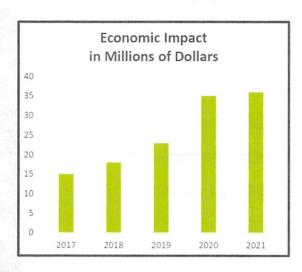

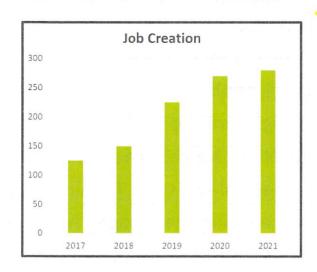
#### A SECOND VILLAGE FOR MEN & A SOCIAL ENTERPRISE

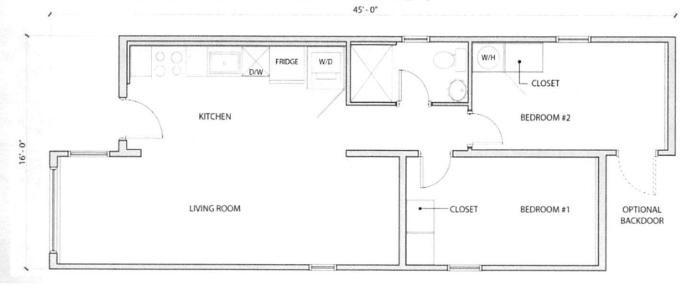

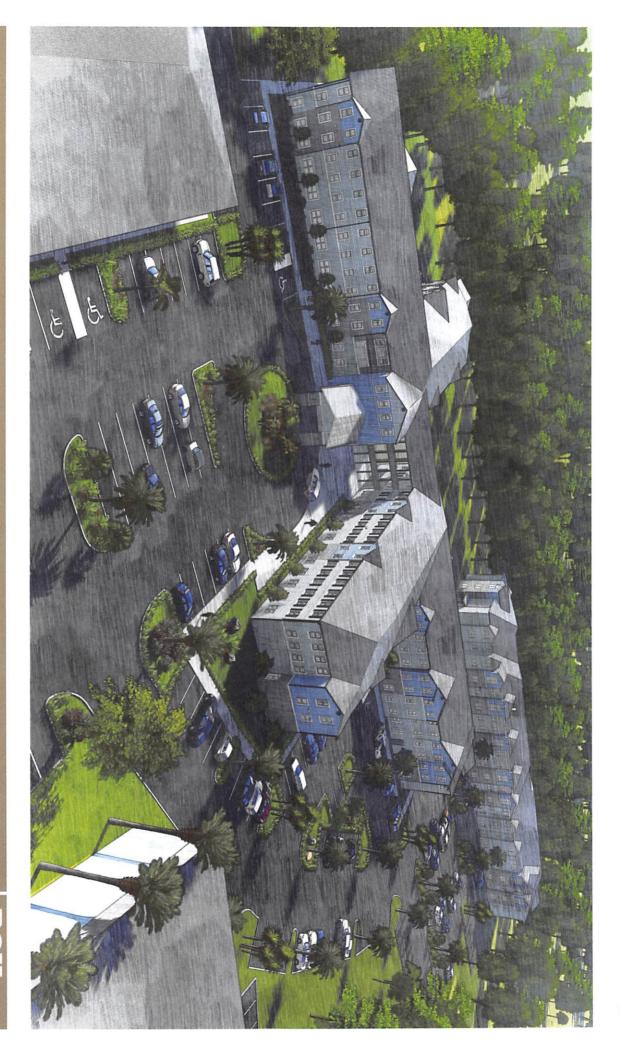
- An example of an urban infill project along transit lines, designed to provide housing for extremely low income individuals.
