5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$5,000 FROM GENERAL FUND OPERATING RESERVES TO THE SUBSIDIES AND 6 7 CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORG ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE 8 FUNDING TO IMPERFECT PEOPLE CENTER, INC., FOR 9 HEALTH AND AWARENESS WORKSHOPS THAT ADDRESS CRITICAL HEALTH ISSUES IN DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA 10 AS ORIGINALLY APPROVED AND AUTHORIZED BY 11 ORDINANCE 2024-462-E; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN 12 13 SECTION 126.108(G) (EXEMPTIONS FROM COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS; 14 15 ETHICS AND TRANSPARENCY IN PUBLIC CONTRACTING), 16 CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH IMPERFECT 17 PEOPLE CENTER, INC.; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 18 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A 19 20 COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 21 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), 22 ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH IMPERFECT PEOPLE CENTER, INC.; APPROVING, 23 AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND 24 25 THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE 26 CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND IMPERFECT PEOPLE 27 CENTER, INC. FOR THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR 28 29 OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACTS COMPLIANCE 30 DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING 31

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: 3 Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, 4 5 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated 6 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) 7 listed in subsection (b): (The account information is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** 8 and 9 incorporated herein by this reference) 10 (a) Appropriated from: See Exhibit 1 \$5,000 11 (b) Appropriated to: 12 See Exhibit 1 \$5,000 13 Explanation of Appropriation: 14 (C) 15 The funding above is an appropriation of \$5,000 from General Fund Operating Reserves to the Subsidies and 16 17 Contributions to Private Org account to provide funding to Imperfect People Center, Inc. ("IPC") for health and 18 awareness workshops aimed at addressing critical health 19 20 issues prevalent in Duval County, Florida (the "Program") 21 as originally appropriated and authorized by Ordinance 22 2024-462-E.

23 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 24 Section 1 is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to IPC 25 for the Program as described in **Exhibit 2**, attached hereto and 26 incorporated herein by this reference. The City funds appropriated 27 herein for this Program were originally appropriated by Ordinance 2.8 2024-462-E and a direct contract with IPC was also authorized pursuant 29 to that legislation. However, the funds were unable to be encumbered 30 prior to the end of the 2023-2024 fiscal year and therefore fell to Operating Reserves. Therefore, this legislation is necessary to 31

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appropriate City funds for the Program in the 2024-2025 fiscal year
and to authorize the requisite direct contract with IPC.

3 Section 3. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.108(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to directly procure 4 the professional services of Imperfect People Center, Inc. for the 5 Program as described herein. Pursuant to Section 126.108(g) 6 7 from competitive solicitation), Part 1 (General (Exemptions Regulations; Ethics and Transparency in Public Contracting), Chapter 8 9 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted 10 from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing 11 legislation. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions 12 of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect. 13

Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. 14 Section 4. The 15 provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), 16 17 Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with Imperfect People Center, Inc. This waiver 18 is justified because IPC has been hosting health awareness workshops 19 20 within the community for over a decade and is well versed in the 21 needs of the target audience. The overall mission of IPC encompasses 22 a comprehensive approach to education, prevention, and support services to empower residents with the knowledge and resources to 23 24 make informed decisions about their health and wellbeing. The City 25 funds appropriated herein will allow IPC to provide health and 26 awareness workshops to reach additional residents in Duval County.

27 Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is 28 hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation 29 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of 30 the City an agreement with Imperfect People Center, Inc. in an amount 31 not-to-exceed \$5,000, subject to the Scope of Services and Budget more particularly described in **Exhibit 2** as previously authorized by
Ordinance 2024-462-E.

3 Section 6. Oversight Department. The Grants and 4 Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee 5 the project described herein.

Requesting Emergency Passage Upon Introduction 6 Section 7. 7 Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage of this legislation upon introduction is requested. 8 The nature of the 9 emergency is that the funds were previously appropriated for the 10 Program but fell to fund balance at the end of the 2023-2024 fiscal year. The Council would like to make the previously authorized grant 11 funds available to IPC as soon as possible for the Program. 12

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
