5 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT'S
6 APPOINTMENT OF MICHAEL HERZBERG, A DUVAL COUNTY
7 RESIDENT, AS A LAY MEMBER OF THE MOBILITY SYSTEM
8 WORKING GROUP, PURSUANT TO SECTION 655.509
9 (MOBILITY SYSTEM WORKING GROUP), PART 5
10 (MOBILITY SYSTEM), CHAPTER 655 (CONCURRENCY AND
11 MOBILITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO
12 SERVE FOR A TERM ENDING WHEN THE CITY COUNCIL
13 TAKES FINAL ACTION ON THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE
14 MOBILITY SYSTEM WORKING GROUP; PROVIDING AN
15 EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **WHEREAS**, Section 655.509, *Ordinance Code*, requires the Planning
18 and Development Department to evaluate the Mobility System and Chapter
19 655 (Concurrency and Mobility Management System) of the *Ordinance*
20 *Code* with respect to the Mobility System, within two years following
21 the adoption of the North Florida Transportation Planning
22 Organization's Long Range Transportation Plan ("LRTP"), but at least
23 once every ten years regardless of receipt of the LRTP, and shall
24 update the Mobility System as provided in Section 655.504, *Ordinance*
25 *Code*; and

26 **WHEREAS**, the Planning and Development Department shall conduct
27 an analysis and present recommendations of appropriate amendments to
28 the Mobility System and Chapter 655 to the Mobility System Working
29 Group, which shall be convened for the purpose of reviewing and
30 approving such recommendations; and

31 **WHEREAS**, the Mobility System Working Group shall be comprised

1 of seven members, with one City Council member appointed by the City
2 Council President, two lay citizens appointed by the City Council
3 President, three lay members appointed by the Mayor, and one lay
4 member appointed jointly by the Mayor and the City Council President;
5 and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Planning and Development Department shall provide
7 the Mayor and the Council with recommendations approved by the
8 Mobility System Working Group (the "Recommendations") for action by
9 the legislative and executive branches of government within 90 days
10 after the approval; and

11 **WHEREAS**, all members of the Mobility System Working Group shall
12 serve until the City Council takes final action on the
13 Recommendations; now therefore

14 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

15 **Section 1. Confirmation of Appointment.** The Council hereby
16 confirms the Council President's appointment of Michael Herzberg, a
17 Duval County resident, as a lay member of the Mobility System Working
18 Group, in accordance with Section 655.509, *Ordinance Code*, to serve
19 for a term ending when the City Council takes final action on the
20 Recommendations.

21 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
23 without the Mayor's signature.
