Type of Action: Ordinance Code amendment

Bill Summary: The bill amends Ordinance Code Chapter 51A – Jacksonville Housing Authority – to create a new Section 51A.113 - Annual presentation of affordable housing programs and goals required. The Authority, through its CEO or a designee, would be required to report annually both in person and in writing to the City Council committee responsible for addressing affordable housing issues and to the Finance Committee on its programs, its collaborative efforts with other entities focused on addressing housing issues, and its goals for the upcoming fiscal year.

Background Information: The amendment was introduced by the members comprising the Special Committee on Homelessness and Affordable Housing to create a mechanism by which the City Council can be kept informed on a regular basis about the work of the Housing Authority and its progress toward meeting the city’s affordable housing needs.
