6 **ORDINANCE 2026-337-E**

7 AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SURPLUS TANGIBLE  
8 PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE;  
9 DECLARING THAT CERTAIN 1979 CHEVROLET MALIBU  
10 (VIN 1T19L9D483566, VEHICLE NUMBER 0046-10)  
11 VALUED AT \$15,000 TO BE SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF  
12 THE CITY AND AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF TITLE TO  
13 SAID VEHICLE TO MOG COLLECTION, LLC D/B/A THE  
14 BRUMOS COLLECTION, AT NO COST, IN ACCORDANCE  
15 WITH SUBSECTION 122.812(C), *ORDINANCE CODE*;  
16 WAIVING SECTION 122.305 (UNLAWFUL USE OF CITY  
17 MARKINGS AND TAGS), PART 3 (MUNICIPAL VEHICLES),  
18 CHAPTER 122 (PUBLIC PROPERTY), *ORDINANCE CODE*,  
19 TO ALLOW THAT CERTAIN 1979 CHEVROLET MALIBU (VIN  
20 1T19L9D483566, VEHICLE NUMBER 0046-10) TO RETAIN  
21 ITS JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE INSIGNIA AFTER  
22 TRANSFER FROM THE CITY; DESIGNATING THE  
23 JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO MONITOR THE USE  
24 OF SAID VEHICLE AFTER TRANSFER; PROVIDING FOR A  
25 REVERTER; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR,  
26 OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY  
27 TO EXECUTE A SURPLUS VEHICLE DONATION AGREEMENT  
28 BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND MOG  
29 COLLECTION, LLC D/B/A THE BRUMOS COLLECTION;  
30 REPEALING SECTION 111.396 (MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY  
31 PROGRAM FUND), PART 3 (PUBLIC SAFETY AND

1 COURTS), CHAPTER 111 (SPECIAL REVENUE AND TRUST  
2 ACCOUNTS), *ORDINANCE CODE*; PROVIDING FOR  
3 OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE;  
4 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.  
5

6 **WHEREAS**, the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office created the "Beat the  
7 Heat" Safety and Education program (the "Program") in 1984 to educate  
8 youth in Jacksonville about the problems of illegal drug and alcohol  
9 use and alcohol or drug impaired driving, to promote a better  
10 understanding between the Sheriff's Office and the communities it  
11 serves, and to discourage drag racing on the streets of the City; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the primary vehicle used for the Program was a 1979  
13 Chevrolet Malibu police vehicle retrofitted as a racetrack certified  
14 drag racing car; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office no longer operates  
16 the Program and has submitted the vehicle for surplus; and

17 **WHEREAS**, MOG Collection, LLC d/b/a The Brumos Collection  
18 (hereinafter, "Brumos") desires to recognize and maintain the  
19 educational value of the vehicle by displaying it in a museum operated  
20 by Brumos and in other City-approved locations; now therefore

21 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

22 **Section 1. Declaration of Surplus.** The City hereby  
23 declares that certain 1979 Chevrolet Malibu (VIN 1T19L9D483566,  
24 Vehicle Number 0046-10) valued at \$15,000 as more particularly  
25 described in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated  
26 herein by this reference (the "Surplus Vehicle"), to be surplus to  
27 the needs of the City of Jacksonville and authorizes the appropriate  
28 City officials to transfer title to said Surplus Vehicle to MOG  
29 Collection, LLC d/b/a The Brumos Collection, at no cost, pursuant to  
30 subsection 122.812(c), *Ordinance Code*. A copy of the Certification  
31 Declaration of Surplus from the Chief of the Procurement Division

1 certifying compliance with the provisions of Chapter 122, *Ordinance*  
2 *Code*, is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this  
3 reference.

4 **Section 2. Public Purpose.** The Surplus Vehicle was used by  
5 the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office as part of the "Beat the Heat"  
6 Program to educate Jacksonville's youth about the dangers of street  
7 drag racing. In 1984 a race car engine was installed in the Surplus  
8 Vehicle to assist JSO in use of this educational tool in furtherance  
9 of the Program.

10 Brumos Racing was one of the sponsors of the vehicle and provided  
11 funding for its operation. By donating the Surplus Vehicle to be  
12 housed at the Brumos Museum and for display in other professionally  
13 organized and reputable car collection and educational venues in  
14 Duval County and St. Johns County, the education and safety awareness  
15 purposes to which the car was put can continue. The City of  
16 Jacksonville finds that transfer of the Surplus Vehicle to MOG  
17 Collection, LLC d/b/a The Brumos Collection for continued display as  
18 an educational tool regarding the dangers of street drag racing is a  
19 valid public purpose. For these foregoing reasons and pursuant to  
20 subsection 122.812(a), *Ordinance Code*, the public interest supports  
21 the disposal of the Surplus Vehicle to Brumos at no cost.

22 **Section 3. Waiver of Section 122.305 (Unlawful use of City**  
23 **markings and tags), *Ordinance Code*.** Section 122.305 (Unlawful use  
24 of City markings and tags), Part 3 (Municipal Vehicles), Chapter 122  
25 (Public Property), *Ordinance Code*, is hereby waived to allow that  
26 certain 1979 Chevrolet Malibu (VIN 1T19L9D483566, vehicle number  
27 0046-10) to retain its Jacksonville Sheriff's Office insignia and  
28 markings so that Brumos may display it as an educational tool in  
29 keeping with its purpose as part of the "Beat the Heat" Safety and  
30 Education Program.

31 **Section 4. Designating the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office to**

1 **Monitor Use of Surplus Vehicle.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office  
2 is hereby designated to monitor Brumos's display and educational use  
3 of the Surplus Vehicle in accordance with the purposes set forth  
4 herein.

5 **Section 5. Reverter.** The disposition authorized herein is  
6 conditioned upon use of the Surplus Vehicle for the purposes set  
7 forth herein for the greater of 5 years or the time during which the  
8 Surplus Vehicle retains Jacksonville Sheriff's Office insignia, and  
9 is further conditioned upon Brumos's agreement to convey the Surplus  
10 Vehicle back to the City of Jacksonville in the event it is not used  
11 for those purposes.

12 **Section 6. Approval and Authorization to Execute Agreement.**  
13 There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the  
14 Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute for and on  
15 behalf of the City, a Surplus Vehicle Donation Agreement between the  
16 City of Jacksonville and MOG Collection, LLC, d/b/a The Brumos  
17 Collection, in substantially the form attached hereto as **Revised**  
18 **Exhibit 3**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 3, Rev Surplus Agree, May 18,  
19 2026 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference (the  
20 "Agreement"), setting forth additional terms and conditions relative  
21 to Brumos's receipt and use of the Surplus Vehicle as authorized  
22 herein.

23 **Section 7. Repealing Section 111.396 (Motor Vehicle Safety**  
24 **Program Fund), Part 3 (Public Safety and Courts), Chapter 111 (Special**  
25 **Revenue and Trust Accounts), Ordinance Code.** Section 111.396 (Motor  
26 Vehicle Safety Program Fund), Part 3 (Public Safety and Courts),  
27 Chapter 111 (Special Revenue And Trust Accounts), *Ordinance Code*, is  
28 hereby repealed in its entirety. A copy of the repealed Section  
29 111.396 is attached hereto as **Exhibit 4**.

30 **Section 8. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office  
31 shall have oversight of the Agreement described herein.
