Allegis Group, Inc., a global talent solutions company, was founded in 1983. The Company provides a full suite of complementary talent solutions that solve nearly every workforce challenge across a variety of clients and industries. Pursuant to Resolution 2022-449-A the company entered into an Economic Development Agreement (EDA) dated July 29, 2022 to expand its existing Jacksonville operations. As part of the EDA the Company committed to an estimated \$1.3 million of private capital investment, as well as the retention of its existing 715 employees and the creation of 500 new jobs, at an average wage of \$53,000, by the end of 2026.

The original EDA contemplated four (4) locations on Jacksonville's southside, including: 7077 Bonneval Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32216; 10375 Centurion Parkway North, Jacksonville, Florida 32256; 10401 Deerwood Park Boulevard, Jacksonville, Florida 32256; and 10752 Deerwood Park Boulevard South, Jacksonville, Florida 32256

The lease term for the first two (2) locations noted above ended in 2023, at which time the Company determined that relocation to a single facility at Salisbury Road would better support the business operations for the sales team. The Deerwood campus, containing the support/administrative staff, would remain at their existing location. The lease term for the Salisbury Road location runs through 2029, which aligns with the Deerwood campus lease term.

Amendment One to the EDA would replace the Bonneval Road and Centurion Parkway North offices with the Salisbury Road office: 4655 Salisbury Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32256; 10401 Deerwood Park Boulevard, Jacksonville, Florida 32256; and 10752 Deerwood Park Boulevard South, Jacksonville, Florida 32256

As of calendar year 2023 the Company reported approximately \$3.9 million of private capital investment and 1,040 jobs at an average wage of \$56,850, with 325 new full-time equivalent jobs. Of the jobs reported, 114 were located at the Salisbury Road location; however, since that location is not specifically

defined in the EDA, the jobs cannot be counted towards the annual benchmarks. This negatively impacts the Company's average wage, as the sales team typically earns higher salaries than the support/administrative staff. As such, the Office of Economic Development recommends amending the EDA to update the description of the Project Parcel (Exhibit A).

The maximum amount of previously approved City incentives will remain unchanged, at \$750,000. This includes a Targeted Industry Employment Grant of \$1,500 per job, payable in 25% increments over four years, after the average wage and job created is verified by the City. To-date the City has paid \$37,500 to the Company. These funds are appropriated annually during the City's Budget Process.
