7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$45,130.14 FROM THE
8 DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY/FEDERAL
9 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) THROUGH THE
10 FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
11 (FDEM) TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF
12 A HEAVY DUTY TOW VEHICLE FOR THE INFECTIOUS
13 DISEASE RESPONSE UNIT, AS INITIATED BY REVISED
14 B.T. 20-105; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS
15 DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO
16 EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE
17 CITY, THE FEDERALLY-FUNDED SUBAWARD AND GRANT
18 AGREEMENT BETWEEN FDEM AND THE CITY OF
19 JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE
20 EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DIVISION; PROVIDING AN
21 EFFECTIVE DATE.

23 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

24 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
25 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
26 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
27 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

30 NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference)

5 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

6 The funding above is a Fiscal Year 2020 Emergency
7 Management Performance Grant Program COVID-19
8 Supplemental (EMPG-S) in the amount of \$45,130.14 from
9 the U. S. Department of Homeland Security/Federal
10 Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) through the State of
11 Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) for the
12 purchase of a heavy duty tow vehicle for the Infectious
13 Disease Response Unit.

14 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the EMPG-S is to
15 assist local governments with their public health and emergency
16 management activities supporting the prevention of, preparation
17 for, and response to the ongoing Coronavirus Disease 2019 public
18 health emergency. The appropriation in Section 1 will be used to
19 purchase one heavy duty tow vehicle for the Infectious Disease
20 Response Team that will support the Emergency Preparedness
21 Division's logistics and supply chain management for COVID-19
22 public health response operations, such as alternate care sites,
23 points of dispensing and distribution, healthcare facility PPE, and
24 COVID-19 screening and testing sites. The grant period expires June
25 30, 2021.

26 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby
27 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary
28 are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of
29 the City, the Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement between
30 the Division of Emergency Management and the City of Jacksonville,
31 in substantially the same form placed **On File** with the Office of

1 Legislative Services.

2 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Emergency Preparedness Division
3 will provide oversight.

4 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
5 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
6 without the Mayor's signature.
