WHEREAS, On June 13, 1902, Emma Virginia Kelly organized the Daughters of Elks in Norfolk, Virginia, the group was later adopted by the Grand Lodge and became an auxiliary body to the Brothers of Elks. The first Temple was Norfolk Temple No. 1, Norfolk, Virginia; and

WHEREAS, by living out their principles of Charity, Justice, and Fidelity, the Elks make a difference by touching the lives of people of all sorts, from seniors to young people, and from the disadvantaged to the disenfranchised; and

WHEREAS, James S. Genwright was the longest serving Ruler, serving at the Jacksonville Maceo Elks Lodge; and
