ORDINANCE 2025-734-E

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF \$10,000
ORIGINALLY APPROPRIATED BY ORDINANCE 2024-601-E
TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2026, SO THE FUNDS REMAIN
AVAILABLE FOR FUTURE APPROPRIATION FOR A NEW
STRATEGIC INITIATIVE IDENTIFIED BY THE COUNCIL
DISTRICT 14 COUNCIL MEMBER; REQUESTING EMERGENCY
PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2024-601-E, funds were
appropriated into a Special Council Contingency account to provide
funding to support the strategic initiatives proposed by Council
Member Johnson for the 2024-2025 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, \$10,000 remains in the Contingency account for this
purpose; and

WHEREAS, to ensure these funds remain available for future
appropriation once a new strategic initiative is identified by the
Council District 14 Council Member, the Council intends for these
funds to carryover to Fiscal Year 2025-2026; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Carryover. The \$10,000 remaining in the Special
Council Contingency account at the end of Fiscal Year 2024-2025 to
support the Council District 14 Council Member's strategic
initiatives shall not lapse but shall carryover to September 30,
2026.

Section 2. Requesting Emergency Passage Upon Introduction
Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage upon

1 introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the
2 emergency is that the funds appropriated herein will lapse on
3 September 30, 2025, and will no longer be available to support the
4 Council District 14 Council Member's strategic initiatives.

5 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
6 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
7 without the Mayor's signature.
