**ORDINANCE 2025-66-E**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A \$107,112.00 GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY ("DHS") TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE CITY'S ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY DIVISION'S MONITORING DEMONSTRATION STUDY PROGRAM 2025 BUDGET, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 25-030; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF TWO FULL-TIME POSITIONS WITHIN THE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY DIVISION OF THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 24-198; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT AND REPORTING BY THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT, ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

**Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of

1           \$107,112.00 in grant funding from the U.S. Department of  
2           Homeland Security ("DHS") to fund the Monitoring  
3           Demonstration Study program for Fiscal Year 2024-2025. The  
4           grant period commences on June 1, 2024 and ends on May 31,  
5           2025. No City match is required.

6           **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
7           Section 1 is to fund the Environmental Quality Division's Monitoring  
8           Demonstration Study program ("Program"). The Program provides for  
9           two (2) staff members to perform various air pollution monitoring  
10          functions within Duval County in accordance with requirements  
11          outlined by DHS.

12          A copy of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Notice of  
13          Award is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this  
14          reference.

15          **Section 3. Authorizing Addition of Two Full-Time Positions.**  
16          There is hereby approved the addition of two full-time positions  
17          within the Environmental Quality Division as more fully described in  
18          R.C. 24-198, attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by  
19          this reference.

20          **Section 4. Oversight and Reporting.** The Neighborhoods  
21          Department, Environmental Quality Division, shall oversee  
22          administration of the grant described herein and shall be responsible  
23          for submittal of the required reports as may be required the grant  
24          agreement, and shall provide oversight of the Program and the  
25          positions described herein.

26          **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
27          effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
28          without the Mayor's signature.
