The Neighborhoods 21 Department, Environmental Quality Division, shall oversee 22 administration of the grant described herein and shall be responsible for submittal of the required reports as may be required the grant 23 24 agreement, and shall provide oversight of the Program and the 25 positions described herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
