Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Lisa Strange Weatherby, to the Jacksonville Housing Authority, replacing Andre Green, for a first full term to expire on September 16, 2026.

Background Information: The Jacksonville Housing Authority is established pursuant to Chapter 51A, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to within its area of operation, prepare, carry out, acquire, lease, and operate housing projects; and provide for the construction, reconstruction, improvement, alteration, or repair of any housing project or any part thereof.

Section 51A.103, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the seven members of the board shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation of the Council.

Ms. Weatherby holds a bachelor's degree in business administration from UNF and she is a 38-year veteran of the financial services industry. She joined the Investment Management Consultant's Association in 1989, was one of the first 50 finance professionals to achieve the Certified Investment Strategist (CIS) designation from the NYU Stern Business School, and currently works as the Vice President-Investments Weatherby Alexander Financial Group of Wells Fargo Advisors. Ms. Weatherby is an Emeritus board member of Volunteers in Medicine, a founding member of the Jacksonville Women's Giving Alliance, and past vice-chair and chair of the JEA board.
