WHEREAS, Jacksonville Public Library has a mission to enrich lives, build community, and foster success by bringing people, information, and ideas together; and

WHEREAS, libraries play a crucial role in the education and development of children, from early childhood reading programs to homework help and college planning for high schoolers; and

WHEREAS, since 1987, Library Card Sign-up Month has been held each September to mark the beginning of the school year, and during this month, libraries unite in a national effort to ensure every child signs up for their own library card; and

WHEREAS, public libraries and library staff will assist parents and caregivers throughout the school year by saving hundreds of dollars on educational resources and services for students; and

WHEREAS, a library card is one of the most cost-effective backto-school supplies available, providing free access to technology, research, books, videos, digital content, library spaces, enriching and educational events, and helpful library staff members; and

WHEREAS, libraries help people of all ages navigate the complexities of life, providing access to research, information, and government services that allow everyone to lead more productive and

fulfilling lives; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

During this month, all Duval residents who do not have a Jacksonville Public Library card are encouraged to obtain one for free, online or at any Jacksonville Public Library Location.
