6 POLLUTION TAG FEE FUND BALANCE TO REPLACE AGING  
7 AMBIENT AIR MONITORING ANALYZERS, AS INITIATED  
8 BY B.T. 23-094; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

11 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,  
12 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
13 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
14 listed in subsection (b):

21 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:  
22 The funding above comprises \$87,575.00 in Air Pollution  
23 Tag Fee fund balance to replace aging ambient air  
24 monitoring analyzers.

25 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
26 Section 1 is to provide funding to replace two existing ambient air  
27 monitoring analyzers operated and maintained by the Neighborhoods  
28 Department, Environmental Quality Division. These devices are used  
29 to monitor and report levels of air pollutants in Duval County as  
30 required by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (the "EPA").  
31 There are multiple analyzers at seven ambient air monitoring sites

1 throughout the County and the EPA requires these devices to be  
2 replaced every five to seven years.

3       **Section 3.       Effective Date.**   This Ordinance shall become  
4 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
5 without the Mayor's signature.
