WHEREAS, while the regulation of smoking is generally preempted to the Florida Legislature, in June 2022, Governor DeSantis signed legislation amending Section 386.209, *Florida Statutes*, granting city and county governments the authority to ban smoking within the boundaries of public parks; and

WHEREAS, despite significant progress, tobacco use remains one of the leading causes of preventable death and disease in the United States; and

WHEREAS, exposure to secondhand smoke is harmful and widespread and there is emerging evidence that exposure to the aerosol produced by vapor-generating electronic devices may also be harmful; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville owns and maintains public parks for the enjoyment of the City's residents and its visitors and strives to ensure these parks remain a clean and safe environment for recreational activities; and

in order to promote public health, safety and welfare, 1 WHEREAS, 2 the City Council finds that a prohibition of smoking and vaping in 3 City-owned parks will reduce exposure to secondhand smoke and aerosols from vapor-generating devices and promotes a cleaner parks system; 4 5 now, therefore BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: 6 7 Section 1. Incorporation of Recitals. The above recitals are incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference. 8

17 (a) It shall be unlawful for a person to engage in any of the
18 following activities in a City park or designated portion

Smoking tobacco products or use <u>of vapor-generating</u> 21 (3) 22 devices. As used in this subsection, "smoking" shall mean 23 inhaling, exhaling, burning, or otherwise using any tobacco 24 product, or the use of an electronic smoking device or vapor-generating device. "Tobacco product" is defined to 25 26 include cigarettes, pipe tobacco, filtered cigars, chewing tobacco, snuff, snus, or other plant product (including 27 28 marijuana, hemp or other plant-based products) intended 29 for inhalation, and any other lighted tobacco product, whether natural or synthetic, except unfiltered cigars (the 30 regulation of which is pre-empted by Section 386.209, 31

1	Florida Statutes). The Director of Parks, Recreation and
2	Community Services shall update applicable parks policies
3	and signage, as deemed appropriate by the Director, to
4	notify the public of this prohibition. Notwithstanding the
5	foregoing, the presence or absence of signs shall not be a
6	defense to a charge of smoking in violation of this
7	Ordinance.

9	Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become
10	effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
11	without the Mayor's signature.
