**Bill Summary:** This bill authorizes the economic development agreement between the City and Johnson & Johnson Vision Care, Inc., and the payment of the Centurion Facility REV Grant and the Main Street Facility REV Grant. A two-reading passage of this legislation is requested pursuant to Council Rule 3.305. The office of Economic Development will oversee the contract and project. If the Agreement approved by this Resolution has not been signed by the Company within ninety (90) days after the OED delivers or mails the unexecuted Agreement to the Company for execution, then the City Council approvals in this Resolution and authorization for the Mayor to execute the Agreement are automatically revoked.

**Background Information:** The purpose of this legislation is to support the expansion of Johnson & Johnson's manufacturing facility located at 7500 Centurion Parkway and the construction of a new packaging and logistics facility at 815 S. Main Street. This project will create an additional 10 permanent full-time equivalent new jobs in Jacksonville with an average salary, exclusive of benefits, of at least \$65,000 per annum by December 31, 2028, with an estimated aggregate capital investment of \$550,000,000. For the Centurion facility, a 6-year REV grant of \$10,500,000 is authorized; for the Main Street facility, a 5-year REV grant of \$1,500,000 is authorized.
