**Bill Summary:** This bill confirms the Cultural Council's appointment of Jeffrey Drushal to the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee, replacing Angela Strain as one of the seven community representatives, for a first full term ending December 31, 2028.

**Background Information:** The Cultural Service Grant Program Committee is established pursuant to Chapter 118, Part 6, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to recommend to the Cultural Council Board of Directors the organizations to be funded and the amount of the funding. Section 118.605, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the membership of the committee shall include seven individuals selected from community wide and confirmed by the City Council.

Mr. Drushal holds a bachelor's degree from Ashland University and master's degree from UF. He is the Pathology Support Coordinator for Natera, Inc. Mr. Drushal resides in Duval County in council district 8.
