5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$590,000 FROM THE
6 UNDERDRAIN REPLACEMENTS PROJECT TO THE TEATICKET
7 DRIVE UNDERDRAIN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (THE
8 "PROJECT"), AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-077;
9 AMENDING THE 2023-2027 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL
10 IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2022-505-
11 E TO REFLECT THE ADDITION OF THE NEW TEATICKET
12 UNDERDRAIN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND THIS
13 APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE UNDERDRAIN
14 REPLACEMENTS PROJECT TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING
15 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,
19 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
20 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
21 listed in subsection (b):

28 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

29 The funding above represents an appropriation of \$590,000
30 from the countywide Underdrain Replacements Project to fund
31 the Teaticket Drive Underdrain Improvements Project (the

1 "Project").

2 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
3 Section 1 is to transfer available funds from the Underdrain
4 Replacements Project to the new Teaticket Drive Underdrain
5 Improvements Project. Failing underdrains have caused damage to
6 portions of the roadway, curb and gutter, and some of the driveways
7 along Teaticket Drive, a residential street in southwest
8 Jacksonville. The Project will entail replacement of approximately
9 975 linear feet of underdrain along Teaticket Drive from the west
10 cul-de-sac to Dover Cliff Drive North as well as replacement of
11 damaged asphalt pavement, curb and gutter, and concrete driveways.

12 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
13 2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
14 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
15 hereby amended to reflect the addition of the Teaticket Drive
16 Underdrain Improvements Project to the CIP and this appropriation of
17 funds to the Project, as more fully described in the Project
18 Information Sheets attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated
19 herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral
20 of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP
21 review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community
22 because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of the
23 Project.

24 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
25 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
26 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP
27 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute
28 an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the
29 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E
30 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

31 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become

1 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
2 without the Mayor's signature.
