13 ELECTIONS, TO PAY FOR ELECTION EDUCATION AND THE  
14 MAILING OF SAMPLE BALLOTS, AS INITIATED BY  
15 REVISED B.T. 24-102; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE

18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,  
20 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated

3 State, Division of Elections, and will be used for election  
4 education and the mailing of sample ballots.

5 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
6 Section 1 is to provide funding to the City for election education  
7 and the mailing of sample ballots. The State of Florida, Department  
8 of State, Division of Elections, has requested that all remaining  
9 funds related to the HAVA grant program be used to close out the  
10 program.

11 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
12 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
13 without the Mayor's signature.
