## ORDINANCE 2024-740-E

AN ORDINANCE MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS; APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF HRUSTIC BROTHERS, INC. FOR RENEWAL OF ITS CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY (CON) TO OPERATE A CLEAN DEBRIS RECYCLING FACILITY ("FACILITY") WITH MODIFICATION TO ALLOW FOR THE EXPANSION OF THE FACILITY ONTO AN ADJACENT PARCEL; PROVIDING FOR CONDITIONS OF SAID RENEWAL; PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 380, Ordinance Code, Hrustic Brothers, Inc. (the "Applicant") has applied for renewal of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CON) for the continued operation of a clean debris recycling facility (the "Facility") located at 6498 Fayal Drive South, Jacksonville, Florida 32258, R.E. Parcel No. 157138-0900 (the "Property") with modification to allow for the expansion of the Facility onto a parcel adjacent to the Property and located at 11901 Fayal Drive, Jacksonville, Florida 32258, at R.E. Parcel No. 157138-0000; and

WHEREAS, the initial CON authorizing operation of a clean debris recycling facility was granted by Ordinance 2015-374-E and administratively renewed by the Director of the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, based upon the determination of need for the Facility by the City Council, the Solid Waste Division of the Department of

Public Works supports approval of the application for renewal and modification of the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the Applicant, provided the Applicant agrees to accept and comply with the Specific Operating Conditions contained in **Exhibit 1**, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has caused a public hearing, properly noticed, to be held before the Council Committee to which matters regarding public utilities are referred, as required by Chapter 380, Ordinance Code, and has made certain findings with respect to said application; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Making Findings. Based upon the criteria set forth in Section 380.105, Ordinance Code, and the comments and recommendations of the Director of the Planning and Development Department, the Chief of the Solid Waste Division, the Chief of the Environmental Quality Division, and the Florida Department of Health in Duval County, the Council finds that the Facility would serve the public convenience and provide a needed service to the citizens of Duval County.

Section 2. Renewal and Modification of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CON) Granted. In accordance with Chapter 380, Ordinance Code, the City of Jacksonville hereby grants renewal and modification of the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CON) to the Applicant for the continued operation of a clean debris recycling facility on the Property and the expansion of such facility onto the adjacent parcel located at located 11901 Fayal Drive, Jacksonville, Florida 32258, at R.E. Parcel No. 157138-0000, all as described in Exhibit 1, and as described in the submitted and approved application.

Section 3. Conditions. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity shall be subject to the conditions set
