WHEREAS, the Council established the Homelessness Initiatives Commission (the "Commission") pursuant to Ordinance 2024-111-E (the "Enabling Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Commission is unable to meet the September 1, 23 2024 deadline for the creation of an annual Action Plan and the 24 December 31, 2024 deadline for the creation of a five-year Strategic 25 Plan, all as set forth in the Enabling Ordinance, due to an unforeseen 26 delay in the initial member appointments to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Commission voted at its August 15, 2024 meeting to request the Council to extend the Strategic Plan and Action Plan deadlines by one year to permit the Commission to have enough time to prepare the same, as reflected in the Meeting Minutes attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference; and

In addition to such powers, duties and authority as may be set forth elsewhere in the Ordinance Code, the Commission is hereby authorized to:

(d) Create a five-year Strategic Plan outlining appropriate programs, services and initiatives to combat homelessness - this Strategic Plan should be tailored to address the unique needs of Duval County's homeless and chronic unhoused populations; the initial Strategic Plan shall be presented to the Council committee of reference tasked with reviewing making recommendations and on measures addressing homelessness on or before December 31, 20242025; Create an annual Action Plan that includes specific goals (e) and measurables to effectuate the Strategic Plan; the initial Action Plan shall be presented to the Council committee of reference tasked with reviewing and making recommendations on measures addressing homelessness on or before March 31, 2025September 1, 2024;

(f) Annually review the Strategic Plan and Action Plan and make recommendations to the Council committee of reference tasked with reviewing and making recommendations on measures addressing homelessness for updates and changes to both Plans on or before March 1 each year beginning March 1, 2026;

herein. Such editorial changes and any others necessary to make the 1 Ordinance Code consistent with the intent of this legislation are 2 3 approved and directed herein, and changes to the Ordinance Code shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered. 4
