Presentation on Procurement Single Source Contracts - 2nd Quarter FY 24/25

Dustin Freeman, Chief of Procurement, spoke about single source purchases, required by Code to be reported to the Finance Committee quarterly. He said that this quarter there were 17 single source purchase orders totaling \$2,506,434.69 and 1 purchase order agreement totaling \$1,353,203.18. Mr. Freeman briefly reviewed the list on the handout that specified the city departments for each item. There were no questions from the committee members.

Kim Taylor provided an update on the external audit. She said that legislation for the agreement with Carr, Riggs & Ingram for 2025, 2026 and 2027 will be filed this cycle and the committee agreed that it will be introduced by the Finance Committee.

Guy Parola, DIA, and David McGowan, WJCT, spoke about the history and terms of the lease, the role of the state of Florida with the property, and the disruption to the property from construction related to the new fire station and adjacent roadway. Mr. McGowan emphasized the time spent and extensive collaboration involved with this lease agreement amendment. Council Member Howland suggested the possibility of relocating the station to a different facility. He also mentioned including the \$30,000 disbursement in the annual budget.

Council Member Arias said that the construction disruption warrants compensation from the City.
